

#### POND COMMITTEE REPORT

#### Update on ponds 7, 2, & 9

The project with AUE land is in progress on pond 7 with progress on the installation of the wall that will be the barrier that restrains the soil to be filled in behind it to fill a previously soggy area of an unattractive growth of weeds and other undesirable growth on pond 7. The fill being

installed behind the retaining wall is being recovered from pond 2 and pond 9. The recovery of the soil pond 2 will result in a savings of thousands of dollars for the reason that if it was not used in pond 7 the soil being removed from pond 2's remediation would have to be trucked to a waste site that is authorized by the EPA to receive soil waste and dumping fees paid. Pond 9 is also being remediated and likewise the soil removed is being utilized in pond 7 and thus avoiding trucking costs and dumping fees for EPA approved site. The soil placed behind the retaining wall on pond 7 will create a generally level area that will have a grass covering created by hydro-seeding, a process that is less costly than sodding. These combined projects will, in part, reduce the effects of erosion in ponds 7, 2, and 9 and enhance the appearance of the ponds.



So, when your dog needs to go, be sure to properly dispose of it. Not only will this keep the community looking better, but it will help keep groundwater clean and help prevent the spread of fecal-borne diseases. *Please utilize the pet waste stations located throughout our community*.

**Please also be cognizant of your dog kicking mulch, sod or other areas**. If this occurs, please try to remediate the area back to its original state.
